

## MPH DEGREE BREADTH REQUIREMENTS

***All breadth courses must be taken for a letter grade except PH 297***

A passing grade for a Breadth Course Requirement is a "B-". MPH students must take Breadth Course Requirements (PH 142; PH 200C1; PH 200C2; PH 200C3 and PH 250A) for a Letter grade. This also applies for the alternative courses which are listed below. Students attaining less than a "B-" will be required to retake the course to qualify for graduation.
